## BIBLE PASSAGE

Read together the story from Luke 24:36b-48 and then consider the questions below:

- The disciples were scared when they saw Jesus initially, what things scare you?
- Would you have touched Jesus' hands and feet?
- How would you feel knowing that Jesus had risen from the dead?

As the disciples had been hiding away, Jesus appeared to them. Initially, they were scared and frightened, but Jesus said, "Peace be with you". He showed them His hands and feet and asked them to touch. As they were stunned in amazement, Jesus asked for some food and shared fellowship with them. He went onto say that they needed to stay in Jerusalem until more instructions were given and they would be empowered by the Holy Spirit.

How to make Hand Wreaths!

You'll need: coloured card, pens, glue/scissors & string
